The centre keeps operating

Our office becoming a hotline centre is not novel or a rare occasion. In fact, HAC operates as a hotline centre 24/7 during a specific time of the academic year, which is at the time of the incoming of new students at the start of the first semester.

Officers on duty to operate the hotline centre range from the official staff that are working regularly at the office, or the student ambassadors appointed by the centre to represent HAC and to assist USM's students' regarding accommodation matters.









Students can dial the HAC's regular phone line to reach for a consultation/tips/help regarding accommodation, sudden arrival during non-office hours, weekends, holidays and any other non-business hours.

In addition to being available round the clock, the 24-hour hotline expands accessibility to students because many students may want to be provided with immediate help or on-the-ground assistance for emergency assistance. At HAC, we do all that and more.

Callers will not only get immediate help but will have the option of receiving follow-up support from HAC staff the next business day so that help is ongoing rather than a one-time event.

Roles and Responsibilities

Since January 2021, Khor Tze Win, has been the magic behind the curtain when it comes to facilitating the isolation procedure of newly arrived students who arrive newly on campus. Win's role was to ensure that meals are sent to the students, to ensure their well being, and to maintain communication with those being isolated. Win got in touch with the students on a daily basis to record their food orders and to make sure they order on time. Win also responded to the students' inquiries and their concerns during isolation. Win also coordinated the swab test for the isolated students.

Aman Damai

The story behind the design

Aman Damai, being the first ever established accommodation in USM, has undergone renovation and upgrading of the rooms and the facilities inside the block. USM's Vice-Chancellor dedicated special funding to sponsor the project. The project was given the name 'Desasiswa Facelift'.

The renovation of Aman Damai consists of 25 rooms (14 premium and 11 standard) that cater to the comfort of those who are differently abled (PKU). The rooms are up to the standards of universal design and standards. By doing that, Aman Damai breaks the record as the first ever accommodation in all USM campuses that host students with special needs and provide convenient and suitable facilities to them.

Part of the upgrade that happened to Aman Damai complex is the provision of newly upgraded toilets that cater to the specially able students, as well as new cafes and varieties of food to meet the various tastes of the students living there.



USM 58TH CONVOCATION FEAT. HAC

With the start of the festive month, December, USM finally held its 58th convocation after being put on hold for two years due to the pandemic. The convocation ceremony came in two sessions, the first session was held in Istana Arau, for the honorary degree holders.
